Instructor Training Course**

How to Get the Training

Individuals or organizations may receive the Instructor Training Program in one of two ways. The first way is through the pre- or post- training program at the annual International Boating and Water Safety Summit in the spring or the annual National Association of State Boating Law Administrators Conference in the fall. The second way is for an organization or agency to organize a special training workshop at their location.

For individuals seeking to enroll in the Instructor Training Program, the best option would be to take the program at one of the pre- or post- training opportunities offered at the annual International Boating and Water Safety Summit (spring) and the annual National Association of State Boating Law Administrators Conference (fall). Registration for these two training venues is \$275 per instructor candidate 30 days prior to the scheduled course date.

Organizations or agencies that would like to schedule the Instructor Training Program at their location should contact the National Safe Boating Council (NSBC) at 703-361-4294 or by e-mail at office@safeboatingcouncil.org.

Cost for the special training workshop for a NSBC member organization is \$2,400 plus travel costs for two instructors. This registration fee includes all course materials and a certificate for a maximum of 12 students. Training is three 8-hour days. Local transportation, including transportation to and from the lodging site to the classroom location, should be provided. Cost for a non-member organization is \$3,200. However, this cost can be negotiated depending on the number of instructor candidates.

Classroom site and location arrangements for the training are the responsibility of the requesting agency. The classroom should include an audio visual LCD projector and a white board (chalk board) or flip charts.

Organizations and agencies should provide at least 30 to 60 days notice to schedule a workshop (less time is possible depending on schedule).
